God's Peace Treaty With Earth (02)

I find it interesting that God sent a large heavenly military (strateia) [host] choir for the announcement of a Peace Treaty with the Earth at the birth of His Only Begotten Son.

It is recorded in the most read Christmas Bible stories of the birth of Jesus Christ (Luke2:1-20).

We will examine our lesson text by the following four homiletical points.

 Performance 	(Lk.2:13a)	God's military choir
 Praise song 	(Lk.2:13b-14a)	Glory to God and peace on earth
 Peace treaty 	(Lk.2:14b)	God's peace through Christ (Rom.5:1)
 Peace-makers 	(Lk.2:15-20)	God's ambassadors of reconciliation (2 Cor.5:17-21)

Before the military choir sang the new praise song, Glory in Excelsis Deo, Gabriel outlined God's Peace Treaty with the earth (Lk.2:10-12; Isa.52:7; Rom.10:15).

We will examine it by the following two homiletical points.

•	Good news	(Lk.2:10)	Universal gospel (Titus 2:11)
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• Global Savior (Lk.2:11-12) Universal salvation (John 1:29; 1 John 2:2)

Today's lesson will study seven aspects of God's Peace Treaty offered to the Earth.

1. God's peace treaty is offered to every member of the human race through gospel of grace salvation.

(Rom.5:1-2) "Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God." [Positional Truth].

God is initiator of this peace treaty with earth (Heb.13:20; 1Thess.5:23; 2 Thess.1:2; Isa.57:19; 1 Cor.14:33).

2. God's peace treaty is offered to every member of the human race because of the 13 judicial charges of Adam's Original Sin (AOS) (Rom.5:12-21; 1 cor.15:22).

Let me mention 4 of the 13 judicial charges of AOS that are important to peace with God (see 50 Things).

• Alienation (Eph.2:12-19; 4:18; Col.1:20-22).

• Enmity (Rom.5:10; Col.1:21)

• Unrighteous (Rom.3:10; 22-24; 10:10; 1 Pet.3:15)

• Ungodly (Rom.1:18; 5:6-8)

To resolve these 13 judicial charges required that someone had to be <u>born outside this slave market of AOS</u>. Jesus Christ was this person! (Luke 1:34-35; 1 Tim.1:15; Rom.5:6-8, 16-19; Gal.4:4-7; 5:1, 13)

3. Therefore Jesus Christ is the sole means of entering into this peace treaty with God (Luke 2:11-14; Acts 10:36; Eph.2:13-17)

(Col.1:20) "And through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made <u>peace through the blood of His cross</u>; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven."

There is no peace with God apart from the gospel of grace salvation (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9).

- (Rom.5:1) "Therefore having been justified by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ." [Positional Truth is 1 of 9 communion factors of the blood of Christ / Eucharist cup]
- 4. Every believer who entered into this peace treaty with God can experience the peace of God by walking by means of the indwelling Holy Spirit (1 Cor.6:19-20; Gal.3:2; Rom.1:16).
 - (Rom.15:13 "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." [Experiential Positional Truth] (Spirituality)

The peace of God is a fruit of the indwelling Holy Spirit:

(Gal.5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, **peace**, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law." (Eph.4:1-3)

5. Carnality hinders the peace of God (1 Cor.3:1-3; James 1:14-15)

Paul warns the believer to be cleansed and to flee youthful lusts and to pursue righteousness, love, and peace. (2 Tim.2:20-22; Rom.14:17).

As a loving Father, God will discipline the **carnal believer** who doesn't confess his sin in order to live a righteous life (1 John 1:9)

- (Heb.12:11) "All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, <u>afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness</u>." (2Pet.3:14); Rom.8:6-9)
- 6. Any spiritual believer can function in the Peace of God amidst great tribulation by walking by means of the power of the Holy Spirit by utilizing the faith cycle (2 Cor.5:7; John 16:33; 14:27).
 - (2 Pet.1:2) "Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord."
 - (Col.3:15-16) "<u>Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts</u>, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. <u>Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you</u>, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs." (Phil.4:6-9)
 - (Isa.26:3) "The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, because he trusts in You."
- 7. As spiritually mature ambassadors of Jesus Christ, the Church Age Believers (CAB) are peace-makers of God's peace treaty while on earth (2 Cor.5:17-21; Eph.6:15; Rom.10:13-15).
 - (Rom.12:18) "If possible, so far as it depends on you, <u>be at peace with all men</u>." (Rom.14:19; 1 Pet.3:1-12) (1 Cor.7:15; Heb.12:14-15; 2 Pet.3:13; 2 Thess.3:16)
 - (James 3:18) "And the seed whose <u>fruit is righteousness is sown in</u> peace by **those who make peace**."
