<u>THE DOCTRINE OF THE SIX STAGES OF GRACE (#4)</u> Growth Maturity Grace

We are currently studying the doctrine of the six stages of God's Grace in the Christ Way of Life (CWL).

- Saving Grace
- Logistical Grace
- Growth Maturity Grace
- Undeserved Suffering Grace
- Dying Grace
- Surpassing Grace.

These five stages of God's Grace cover the entire CWL from salvation to eternity in heaven (2 Cor.5:6-8).

As a pastor-teacher, I was burdened with the task of feeding the Lord's sheep (John 21:15-17). I wasn't theologically trained in how to develop spiritual growth maturity. However, the grace of God met my need by allowing me to learn from another pastor-teacher, R.B. Thieme.

What I have learned about the development of spiritual growth maturity I will share with you in the THIRD STAGE of GRACE (Growth Maturity Grace).

I have discovered the importance of:

- Milk (Soteriology) doctrines for the baby believer
- Meat (Nepiology) doctrines for the immature believer
- Meat (Teleiology) doctrines for the mature believer
- (1 Pet.2:2; Heb.5:13) (2 Pet.3:18; Eph.4:14-15) (Heb.5:14; Col.1:28-29).

Therefore, I speak with confidence when I ask you to study at least one year with us at DSBC and you will "**grow** (auxano) (p.a.impv.2pl) <u>in (en+loc) the grace (charis) and knowledge (gnosis)</u> of our Lord and Savior (soter) **Jesus Christ.**" (2 Pet.3:18) Then you will have something to compare your other church growth experiences.

This lesson will study five aspects of spiritual growth Maturity Grace.

1. Milk (Soteriology) doctrines are essential for spiritual growth of a newborn baby believer to advance to the immature stage of an adult believer. (SEE 50 Things Free at <u>www.doctrinalstudies.com</u>).

Under the principle of grace salvation, every Church Age Believer (CAB) enters the Christian Way of Life(CWL) equal in spiritual growth status as a "brephos", a babe (1 Pet.2:2).

(1 Pet.2:2) "Like **newborn** (artigennetos) **babes** (brephos), long for the <u>pure **milk** of the word</u>, that by it you may grow in respect to salvation (soteria)."

(Heb.5:13) "For everyone who <u>partakes only of **milk**</u> is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he is a **babe** (nepios)."

"They cannot grasp the deeper theology of advanced Christian truth." (Renaissance of NT, pg.194)

(Eph.4:14-15) "As a result, we are no longer to be **children** (**nepios**), tossed here and there <u>by waves</u>, and carried about <u>by every wind of doctrine</u>, <u>by the trickery of men</u>, <u>by craftiness in deceitful scheming</u>; but speaking the truth in love, <u>we are to grow up in all aspects into Him</u>, who is the head, even Christ."

(1 Cor.3:1) "And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, **as to babes** (nepios) in Christ."

2. When a spiritually mature (teleios) believer goes into reversionism (Prov.14:14) [backslides], he relapses to the immature (nepios) stage of spiritual growth.

He doesn't lose his salvation but he does lose his spiritual growth maturity status (John 10:28-30).

(Heb.10:25) "Not forsaking our own assembling together, <u>as the habit of some</u>, but encouraging one another; and the more, as you see the day drawing near." (Heb.13:17; Col.1:25; 1 Pet.5:1-4)

(Heb.5:12-13) "For by this time you ought to be teachers, you have **need again** for <u>someone to teach</u> you the <u>elementary principles of the oracles of God</u>; and you **have come to need milk and not solid food** (**meat**). For everyone who partakes **only of milk** is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he is a **babe** (nepios)."

(Heb.6:1a) "Therefore **leaving** (aphiemi / a.a.ptc.nplm) the <u>elementary teaching about Christ</u>, let us **press** (phero / p.m.subj.1pl) <u>on to **maturity** (ten teleiotes / asf</u>)"

3. Therefore spiritual growth depends on the type of Categorical Bible Doctrine (CBD) being cycled by faith in your Christian Way of Life (CWL).

٠	Newborn baby	(brephos)	needs Soteriology milk doctrines (1 Pet.2:2; Heb.5:13).
٠	Immature believer	(nepios)	needs Nepiology milk doctrines (2 Pet.3:18; Eph.4:14-
	15).		
•	Mature believer	(teleios)	needs Teleiology meat doctrines (Heb.5:14; Col.1:28-29).

• Reversionistic believer needs Nepiology milk doctrines (Heb.5:12-13; 6:1).

4. Spiritual growth is never static. We are either progressive or retrogressive (Eph.4:11-16).

- **Progressive** is moving from **milk** (Soteriology and Nepiology) to **meat** (Teleiology) doctrines. Reaching and maintaining maturity means a steady meat diet of Teleiology doctrines (advanced theology).
- **Retrogression** is either never reaching maturity because of carnality (1 Cor.3:1-3) or relapsing back to immaturity because of reversionism (Heb.5:12-13; 6:1).

5. While there are stages to spiritual growth maturity, there are no stages to spirituality.

- The immature believer (nepios) can be spiritual on milk doctrine because of the indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor.3:1-3; 6:19-20; Eph.5:18; Gal.5:16-17).
- The mature believer (teleios) can be carnal on meat doctrines because of lust trends of the old sinnature (OSN) (Gal.5:16-17; James 1:13-15; 1 Cor.3:1-3) and because of old man cosmos diabolicus thinking (OMCD) (Col.3:5-10; Rom.12:2).

The length of time as a believer or as a member of a church does not determine one's spiritual growth status.

(2 Pet.3:18) "But <u>grow in the grace and knowledge</u> of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen."

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
