### <u>THE DOCTRINE OF THE SIX STAGES OF GRACE (#6)</u> Undeserved Suffering Grace (#2)

We are currently studying the doctrine of the six stages of God's Grace in the Christ Way of Life (CWL).

- Saving Grace
- Logistical Grace
- Growth Maturity Grace
- Undeserved Suffering Grace
- Dying Grace
- Surpassing Grace.

Today's lesson will study the last four aspects of God's <u>Grace</u> called Undeserved Suffering (U/S).

#### 1. Undeserved Suffering is evidence of the spiritually advancing believer's walk with the Lord.

(2 Thess.1:4-5) "Therefore we ourselves speak proudly of you among the churches of God for <u>your</u> <u>perseverance and faith in the midst of all your persecutions and afflictions which you endure.</u> This is a plain indication of God's righteous judgment so that you will be **considered worthy** of the kingdom of God, for which indeed you are setting." (2 Tim.3:10-12) (1 Pet.1:6-7; Heb.5:8)

(Rom.5:3-5) "And not only this, but **we also exult in our tribulations**, knowing that <u>tribulation</u> brings about perseverance; and <u>perseverance</u>, proven character; and <u>proven character</u>, hope; and <u>hope does not</u> <u>disappoint</u>, because the <u>love of God</u> has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us." (Rom.8:35-39) (Phil.3:10; 1 Pet.5:10)

## 2. It is essential that the Church Age Believer (CAB) maintain a Relaxed Mental Attitude (RMA) through Grace Orientation (G/O) to the Plan of God.

(1Pet.4:12-13) "Beloved, <u>do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you</u>, which comes upon you for your <u>testing</u>, as though <u>some strange thing were happening to you</u>; but **to the degree that** you share the **suffering of Christ**, **keep on rejoicing**, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation." (1Pet.4:16; Rom.12:12)

**Example:** Naomi [meaning pleasant] told her neighbors to call her to **Mari** [the bitter one] because of suffering in her life (Ruth 1:20; Prov.14:10; **Heb.12:15**; Prov.15:13)

(1 Pet.4:19) "Therefore, those also who **suffer according to the will of God** shall <u>entrust their soul</u> to a faithful Creator in doing what is right." (2 Cor.1:3-11)

(James 1:2-4) "**Consider it all joy**, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, <u>knowing that the</u> <u>testing of your faith</u> produces **endurance**. And endurance have its perfect result **so that** you may be <u>perfect</u> <u>and complete</u>, <u>lacking nothing</u>." (Col.1:24)

# **3.** Undeserved Suffering is an extension of the Angelic Conflict (A/C) in the life of a spiritually advancing believer.

Job is one example (Job 1:6-11; 2:2-10; 42:7-16).

(Job 42:12a) "The Lord blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning."

(James 5:11) "We count those **blessed who endure**. You have heard of the endurance of Job and have seen the <u>outcome of the Lord's dealings</u>, that the Lord is full of compassion and is merciful."

### Victory in the angelic conflict:

(1 John 5:4-5) "For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this <u>is the victory that overcomes</u> <u>the world</u> – **our faith.** Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God." [Application of the Faith Cycle]
