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WALK IN NEWNESS OF LIFE (part 3)

Walking in newness of life is a study within a study. It is based on our study of baptism of Holy Spirit (BHS) recorded in (Romans 6:3-4).

In today's study, we will study <u>4 aspects of the dynamics</u> of Walking In Newness of Life as recorded in (Rom.6:3-4).

The first two points are review. Watch for a special study of the abundant life that comes out of <u>walking in</u> newness of life as recorded in (John 10:10) in the last two points of this lesson.

1. (Rom.6:3-4) teaches three important doctrines of Positional Truth associated with the Baptism of the Holy Spirit (BHS) and the grace gospel.

The Doctrine of Retro-Active Positional Truth (RAPT) identifies the Church Age Believer (CAB) with the benefits of the spiritual death of Jesus Christ.

(Gal.2:20) "Crucified with Christ" and baptized into His death." <u>The 13 charges of Adam's Original Sin</u> are removed forever. (Rom.6:1-4). <u>Plus 9 communion factors of the blood of Christ</u> (1 John 1:7-9; 1 Cor.11:25-26).

Doctrine of Current Positional Truth (CPT) identifies the Church Age Believer (CAB) with the benefits of burial, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ. This includes the 20 status-privileges in the package of grace salvation (50 Things).

(Eph.2:6) "And **raised us up with Him**, and **seated us** with Him in the heavenly places <u>in Christ Jesus.</u>" (Eph.1:3, 20-23; Col.2:12-13) (Gal.3:27) (IN Christ)

Doctrine of Expiential Positional Truth (EPT) identifies the Church Age Believer (CAB) on earth with personal occupation with Jesus Christ, seated in session in Heaven by means of the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit. This is involves the **8** works of the Holy Spirit (Rom.8:9-11) (1 Cor.12:13) In Church body.

2. There are four important spheres of spiritual truths illustrated by four circles that teach EPT.

3. Experiential Positional Truth (EPT) is Walking in Newness of Life.

(Rom.6:4) "Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, <u>so that as</u> Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, <u>so we too</u> **might walk in newness of life.**"

Walking is peripateo (a.a.subj.1pl)

Walking in newness of life is walking by means of the Indwelling Holy Spirit (Gal.5:16-17).

Walking in newness of life means living in the A<u>bundantance of the Christian Way of Life (CWL)</u> (John 10:10).

In (en+locative of sphere) (2 Cor.5:17; Eph.2:6) Note the Spiritual Circle of point number 2 above.

Newness is kainotes (kainos) [New in form and quality based on Current Positional Truth (CPT). (tes is the "suffix of agent" of life – the agent of Life is the Indwelling Holy Spirit. (1 Cor.11:25; 2 Pet.3:13; 2 Cor.5:17; Eph.4:24)

Life is zoe (divine, eternal) (Luke 12:15; John 1:4; 3:16, 36; 5:24; 1 John 3:14; 10:28-30; 11:25; 14:6)

4. The Newness of Life brings God's Abundant Life to the Spiritually Advancing Believe.

(John 10:10) "The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; **I came** (erchomai / a.m.ind.1ps) that (hina of purpose) they might have (echo / p.a.subj.3pl) **life**, and might have (echo / p.a.subj.3pl) **it abundantly** (perissos)." **The thief is identified in (John10:8, 19-21)**. Lost sheep (Matt.15:24; Luke 15:3-7; 19:10)

The Greek words for <u>abundant and life</u> are **perissos and zoe. Perissos** means superfluous or exceeding sufficiency. **Zoe** means Eternal Life of God.

The abundant life (perissos zoe) is functional part of Eternal Life in the Plan of God.

Elijah and the widow of Zarephath famine meal is an example of the **exceeding sufficiency of God's grace of the abundant life** (1 King 17:14).

- God's Abundant Grace ABOUNDS in the life of the spiritually advancing CAB (2 Cor.9:8; Rom.5:17)
- God RICHLY provides for our needs and even our enjoyment (1 Tim.6:17; Phil.4:19)
- God is able to do IMMEASUREABLY MORE than we ask or think (Eph.3:20)
- Abundant life OVERFLOWS WITH HOPE through the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom.15:13)
