EXAMPLE OF REVERSE PROCESS REVERSIONISM

During Paul first missionary evangelism trip (Acts 13-14), there were many converts from Greco-Roman demonic idolatry to Christianity through the gospel of grace salvation and many churches planted (Gal.1:2, 6).

The first missionary evangelism trip was the discussion of the first church conference recorded in (Acts 15) because the Judaizer's were opposing Paul message of grace salvation by faith:

(Acts 15:24) "Since we have heard that some of our members to whom we gave no instruction have disturbed you with their words, unsettling your souls."

(Gal.1:6) "I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, or a different gospel." (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9).

The Galatians believers had left the grace teaching of Paul for the legalistic teachings of the Judaizers (Gal.4:8-11).

Using today's lesson text we will examine seven factors of the **PROCESS** of slipping into a state of RPR.

(Gal.4:16) "Have I therefore become (ginomai/ **perf**.a.ind.1ps) [completed action in past time that remains completed in preset time] **your enemy** by telling you the truth (aletheuo/ p.a.ptc.nsm)?"

A rhetorical question encouraging them to think about the seriousness of it.

1. NEGATIVE VOLITION

2. CARNALITY

3. REVERSIONISM (2 factors to reversionism)

4. EMOTIONAL REVOLT OF THE SOUL

5. SCARTISSUE

6. RPR (5 factors to RPR)

7. SIN UNTO DEATH (final factor)
