SKEPTICS OF THE RESURRECTION

During January and February, we will study (1 Cor.15:1-58) to understand the Theology for Missions.

Today's lesson is entitled, Skeptics of Resurrection, taken from 1 Cor.15:12-19.

1. <u>Seven (7) dangers of false doctrines are introduced by seven (7) first class conditional</u> clauses (1CC) (1 Cor.15:12, 13, 14, 15b, 16, 17-18, 19).

NOTE: "A First Class Condition (1CC) affirms the reality of the condition" (Summers Greek). In a 1CC - **if** the protasis is true, **then** the apodosis is also true.

The focus of this lesson is upon a phrase Paul used to warn of the dangers of Skeptics of Resurrection – "IF (1CC) THE DEAD ARE NOT RAISED, then..."

In (1 Cor.15:12), Paul opened with the **first of seven** First Class Conditions (**1CC**). But he then asked a question in the apodosis of that first "if / then" clause. Then Paul used the next **six** first class conditions (1CC) to show the **seven dangers** of the false teaching within the Church by the Skeptics of the Resurrection (1 Cor.15:13-19).

2. Paul's opening 'if / then' statement: (1 Cor.15:12) "Now <u>if</u> (protasis) Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, <u>then</u> (apodosis) how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?"

The dangerous false doctrines will be stated in these 7 apodosis clauses.

1. Then (apodosis) - "not even Christ has been raised." (1 Cor.15:13)

2. Then (ara/ inferential particle/ apodosis) our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain." (1 Cor.15:14)

3. (apodosis given first) "Moreover (then) we are even found to be false witness against God that He raised Christ." (1 Cor.15:15) "If in fact (1cc +ara/ protasis) the dead are not raised."

4. Then (apodosis) - "not even Christ has been raised." (1 Cor.15:16)

5. Then (apodosis) - "your faith is worthless, you are still in your sins." (1 Cor.15:17)

6. Then (ara/ apodosis) those also who have **fallen asleep in Christ have perished**." (1 Cor.15:18). (1 Cor.15:17 & 18) apodosis's are working from if (1cc) of (1 Cor.15:17) – "If Christ has not been raised."

7. Then (apodosis) - "we are of all men most to be pitied." (1 Cor.15:19)

"IF THE DEAD ARE NOT RAISED, THEN WE HAVE PERISHED AND ARE MOST TO BE PITIED."
