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VIRTUOUS PRIESTLY SERVICE (Part 2)

This is the sixth lesson in the series entitled, Melchizedek. Our lesson text is one of the longest sentences in the NT (Heb.10:19-25).

In Hebrews Chapters 5-10, the writer has taught on the superiority of high priesthood of Jesus Christ.

In this lesson, he outlines <u>four virtues</u> important to the Church Age Believer's (CAB) priesthood service to the local church body.

How do I know he is talking about the local church? The answer is found in the last verse of our lesson text (Heb.10:25).

- Do you suppose God is smart enough to know about internet communications? Technology like the printing press, radio, TV, etc. through-out the world? [Technology is never ahead of God.]
- Do you suppose God knows that you are not omnipresence (everywhere)?
- The local church is the geographical place of primary priestly service in the Church Age (Acts 20:28; 11:22-26; 14:21-27).

This lesson will study four aspects of the four Virtuous Priestly Services to the local church body.

1. Every Church Age Believer (CAB) is a Royal Priest after the order of Jesus Christ, based on Grace Salvation (1 Pet.2:5, 9).

(1 Pet.2:9) "But you are a chosen race (eklektos genos), a **royal priesthood** (basileios hierateuma), a holy nation (hagios ethnos), a people for God's own possession (laos peripoiesis), **so that (hopos) [divine purpose]** you may proclaim the Excellencies (**tas arête) [the virtues]** of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." (Acts 26:18; Col.1:13-14)

Heb.10:19-25 will identify <u>four divine virtues</u> of the royal priesthood services to the local church body of believers.

Writer of Hebrews divided our lesson text into two sections (Heb.10:19-20 and 10:21-25).

- "Since (oun/inferential conjunction) [understood from Heb.10:17-18] therefore, brethren, <u>we have</u> (echo/p.a.ptc.nplm) confidence (parrhesia/ asm/ direct object of echo)
 - o Confidence is important to our priesthood service to local church.
- "Since we have such [understood from Heb.10:19-20] a great priest (asm/ direct object of echo) over the house of God. (Heb.10:21-25)
 - o Four virtues are important to our priestly service to other believers.
- 2. While our Church Age Believer (CAB) Priesthood is 1 of 20 status privileges of package in grace salvation (50 Things Free), the four Virtues of our Church Age Priesthood service come from our spiritual growth (Eph.4:11-13; Phil.3:15-16).

Confidence of our priesthood status precedes our priesthood service.

The writer of the book of Hebrews identifies **four virtues of priesthood** by <u>three hortatory</u> (p.a.sub.1pl) translated "let us".

The Subjunctive is viewed as possible, contingent upon certain conditions.

The Hortatory subjunctive (first person plural) [let us] encourages others to follow in the action.

FIND THE VIRTUES

- (Heb.10:22) "Draw near" (proserchomai) [Resurrection, Ascension and Session of Jesus] (Heb.4:14-16) **How?**
- (Heb.10:23) "Hold fast" (kathecho) [to have a firm grip on] What?
- (Heb.10:24a) "Consider" (katanoeo) [to have hold of one's attention] What?
- (Heb.10:24b) "Consider" [one's undivided attention] **What?**

(**Titus 2:14**) (kalos) [Divine Good that comes from spiritual growth maturity] Hold fast to the good doctrines (1 Thess.5:21-22).

3. These four virtues of our priesthood service to the local church body are products of our spiritual growth maturity (Heb.10:22-24).

4. The writer of Hebrews, to the believers of his day, closed our lesson text with a warning about how forsaking our assembly affected their priesthood ministry.

(Heb.10:25) "**Not forsaking** (me egkataleipo/p.a.ptc.nplm) our own assembling together (ten episunagogue/asf), as is the habit of some, **but** (alla/adversative) **encourage** (parakaleo/p.a.ptc.nplm) **one another;** and all the more as you see (blepo/p.a.ind.2pl) the day drawing near (The 5th cycle of Divine Discipline upon Israel would occur in 3 – 4 years of the writing)."

Not Forsaking: (Matt.27:46; Acts 2:27, 31; 2 Tim.4:16-17; 2 Cor.4:9; Heb.13:5)

- Every Church Age Believer (CAB) is a Royal Priest based on the resurrection, ascension and session of Jesus Christ.
- Priestly service is given to other Church Age Believers (CABs) on the basis of God's grace in Jesus Christ
- Reaching and maintaining spiritual growth maturity results in the consistent manifestation of the four virtues of the believer-priest's life / walk. (Faith, hope, love and good works Divine Production).
- Forsaking the assembly with the local church body amounts to deserting ones priestly service.
- Intercessory prayer is an important part of our priestly service (1 Tim.2:1-4).
- The exercise of our spiritual gift is a priestly service to our local church body.
 - o (1 Pet.4:10) "As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God." (1 Cor.12:12-27)
