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Text: John 8:48-52

NEVER SEE DEATH

This lesson comes from the third Temple Discourse recorded in John Ch. 8 along with three additional "Truly, Truly" messianic doctrines (Jn.8:34, 51, and 58). We will examine the **lesson text** of the second "Truly, Truly" messianic doctrine (Jn.8:48-52) by four homiletic points.

Calling names (Jn.8:48)Apostate Jews to Jesus

Samaritan and demon possessed.

Charge (Jn.8:49-50) Jesus to Jews

• You dishonor Me.

Conditional promise (Jn.8:51) Jesus to Jews

"Truly, Truly" messianic doctrine

Callous ears and hearts Jews to Jesus – misquoted Jesus (Jn.8:52)

Uncircumcised ears and heart because of Negative Volition (NV) (Acts 7:51).

This lesson will study four aspects of the "Truly, Truly" messianic doctrine – Never See Death.

1. Just before these Jews starting name calling, Jesus had warned them of the spiritual problem they were having with Him in (Jn.8:45-47) (Negative Volition (NV) towards the Truth of God's Word).

(Jn.8:47) "**He who** is of God hears the words of God; **for this reason, you do not** hear them, because you are not of God."

Paul taught that the NATURAL MAN (psuchikos) [An unbeliever without the Spirit] cannot accept the things of the Spirit of God (1 Cor.2:14-16). In fact, spiritual matters seem "foolish to him"

The Bible is a spiritual book for spiritual people for spiritual living. The unbeliever is devoid of the Indwelling Holy Spirit.

(Jude 19) "These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit."

(Rom.8:9) "However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him." (1 Cor.6:19-20)

2. What part / role / work does the Holy Spirit have in a person's salvation?

At the moment, a person believes that Jesus died for his/ her sins, was buried and raised from the dead according to the Scriptures, (The Gospel) he/ she receives eight (8) works of the Holy Spirit.

Why? Because he lives in the Church Age and under the New Covenant (1 Cor.11:24-25; Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9).

<u>Adoption</u>	(Rom.5:15-17)	<u>Sanctification</u>	(2 Thess.2:13-14)
Baptism	(1 Cor.12:13)	<u>Sealing</u>	(Eph.4:13-14; 4:30)
<u>Indwelling</u>	(1 Cor.6:19-20)	Spiritual gift	(1 Cor.12:11)
Regeneration	(Jn.3:3-8)	Spiritual life	(Rom.8:9-11)

(2 Cor.5:17) "Therefore **if anyone is in Christ**, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come."

3. These unbelieving religious Jews were expressing their position in Adam, one of enmity!

Principle: Every member of the human race is born in Adam and under <u>13 judicial charges</u> of Adam's Original Sin (AOS).

(1 Cor.15:22) "For as **in Adam** <u>all die</u> (physical birth), so also in Christ <u>all will be made alive</u> (spiritual birth)." <u>Doctrine of Positional Truth</u> (Col.1:13-14)

ENMITY:

(Rom.5:10) "For if while **we were enemies**, we were <u>reconciled to God through the death of His Son</u>, **much more**, having been <u>reconciled</u>, we shall be saved by His life."

(Eph.2:15-16) "By **abolishing in His flesh the enmity**, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make two into one new man, thus **establishing peace**, **and might reconcile** them both in one body to God through the cross, by **it having put to death the enmity."**

4. Jesus gave these unbelieving Jews an important messianic doctrine of grace salvation. It was worthy of a double AMEN ("it shall be so" – "So let it be so.")

Conditional Promise:

(Jn.8:51) "Truly, truly, I say to you, 'If (3cc) [maybe] anyone keeps (tereo/ a.a.subj) [pay attention to important details] My word he will never (ouk –me) [No, Not Ever!] see (theoreo/ a.a.subj) [personally experience spiritual death or the Second Death] (Rev.20:14-15) death (thanatos) [spiritual] (Rom.5:12) [1 of 13 charges of AOS]."

These Jews misquoted this important messianic doctrine (Jn.8:52) – 'Never **taste (geuomai)** [they changed the word to fit their theology] (**a.m.subj**) death."

This is what they missed because of Negative Volition towards Divine Truth, The Word of God.

(Heb.2:9) "But we do not see Him who was made for a little while lower that the angels, namely Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He might taste death (thanatos) [spiritual connotations] for everyone."
