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## **NEW MAN TRIAD VIRTUES**

Our series title, **Grieving Holy Spirit**, comes from Eph.4:30. It contains 1 of 11 Greek imperatives (commands) in the greater context of this series which is Eph.4:25-32.

This lesson gives the **spiritual antidote** to the six deadly sins of Old Man Cosmos Diabolicus (OMCD) [Worldly Thinking listed in:

(Eph.4:31) "Be (ginomai/p.a.impv.2pl) [become someone you weren't - which requires an Exchange/4:31) kind (chrestos/aplm) to one another tender-hearted (eusplagehanos/aplm), forgiving (charizomai/p.a.ptc.nplm) each other, JUST AS God in Christ (en+inst. of association/ to one another and to each other) (1 Cor.12:12, 25-26) also has forgiven (charizomai/a.m.ind.3ps) you (su/dplm)."

## This lesson will study the three aspects of the New Man Triad Virtues (Eph.4:20-24).

1. We will begin by reviewing four points from last week's lesson (Old Man Sins listed in Eph.4:31) that will help to understand the New Man Triad Virtues listed in (Eph.4:32).

In Review of (Eph.4:31)

- We learned that Old Man Cosmos Diabolicus (OMCD) [Worldly Thinking] sins are manifestations of one's Former Life" before salvation.
- We learned that every believer is commanded to Put Away (airo/ a.p.impv.3ps) [to lift up and removel (command) OMCD sins.
  - o This involves more than confession of personal sins (1 John 1:9). It involves an exchange of embedded sinful ways believer thinks and behaves.
- We learned that Paul had explained earlier how this exchange works in (Eph.4:20-24) which is one Greek sentence.
  - o Lay aside (OMCD sins) (Eph.4:22) Paul used three infinitives in (Eph.4:31)
  - o **Be renewed** (cycling categorical Bible doctrine (Eph.4:23) (2 Tim3:16-17)
  - o **Put on** (The EXCHANGE) New Man Divine Viewpoint thinking (NMDV)
    - The **Three Triad Virtues** listed in (Eph.4:32)
- We learned that there were three fronts to win in the Christian's way of life (CWL).
  - o Win over flesh (Our Old Sin-Nature) (OSN) (Gal.5:16-17) and walk by means of Indwelling Holy Spirit.
  - Win over sight (cosmos diabolicus/ worldly thinking promoted by Devil (1 John 5:19) and walk by the Faith Cycle (2 Cor.5:7).
  - Win over OMCD by walking by means of New Man Divine Viewpoint thinking (NMDV) applying the Grace Virtues in personal relationships (Eph.4:20-24, 31-32) (Rom.12:2) [Transformation].

2. Our lesson text shows how the <u>exchange and replacement</u> from OMCD to NMDV works in the Christian Way of Life (CWL) (Eph.4:31-32).

In Eph.4:31, Paul listed 6 Old Man Sins that must be put away from you (airo/ lifted up and removed). These are 6 deadly personal sins to personal relationships.

This is brought out in Eph.4:32 with these words (to one another and each other).

Let me give an example of this type of embedded sins effecting personal relationships:

• David and Michal, the daughter of Saul (love for one another) (1 Sam.18:20-21; 19:15; 25:44).

David's treatment of Michal as king is recorded in (2 Sam.3:13-16; 6:20-23)

• Let's take a look at the six deadly sins (bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, slander, and malice recorded in (Eph.4:31) – are any evident in this relationship?

What should David have done as a spiritual mature believer according to Paul?

3. Paul listed a triad of Divine Viewpoint virtues of a spiritually mature believer that are the antidote for (OMCD) worldly thinking / sins.

(Eph.4:24) "Be (ginimai/p.a.impv.2pl) <u>kind</u>, <u>tenderhearted</u> and <u>forgiving</u> (charizomai/p.a.ptc.nplm), **Just As** God in Christ **ALSO** has forgiven (charizomai/a.m.ind.3ps) you (all of you)."

What should David have one according to (Eph.4:22-24) and (Eph.4:31-32)?

"Just As God in Christ forgive you, be forgiving to others." Forgiving is how you treat others - Be kindness and Be tender-hearted.
