INDWELLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We ae currently studying the Foundation Doctrines of Holy Spirit taught by Jesus to His disciples before and after His crucifixion.

These foundation doctrines were introduced at the Last Supper (John 14-16) and continued until His Ascension (Acts 1:5-9).

We learned from our last study that this lesson comes from the Philip section (John 14:8-21/14:16-18).

This lesson will study <u>four aspects</u> of the First Foundation Doctrine entitled, The Indwelling of Holy Spirit.

1. An outline of the lesson text (John 14:16-18).

NOTE: Pay attention to the Godhead: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

•	(John 14:16)	God, the Son God the Father God the Spirit	"I will ask the Father" "He will give you Another Helper" "He may be with you forever."
•	(John 14:17)	God the Spirit	"That is the Spirit of Truth"

Unbelievers vs Believers:

(John 14:17) "*that is* the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but YOU know Him **because He abides** (meno/ p.a.ind.3ps) **with** (para+loc) [place/ beside] **you and will be** (eimi/ <u>f.m.ind3ps</u>) **in** (en+loc) [place/ indwelling] **you.**"

God the Son's promise to His disciples between His Ascension and Pentecost (John 20:22)

(John 14:18) **"I will not leave** (nok aphiemi/ f.a.ind.1ps) **you as orphans**; **I will come** (erchomai) (p.a.ind.1ps) **to you** (believers)."

(John 20:22) "And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.""

2. At the moment of Grace Salvation, by faith in the Gospel of Jesus Christ, God the Holy Spirit accomplishes eight works for every Church Age Believer! (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9; John 14:16-18)

3. The Holy Spirit permanently indwells every Church Age Believer's body from the moment of salvation to dying grace or the rapture (John 14:16-18; Rom.8:9-11) (1 Thess.4:13-18).

Every Church Age Believer becomes a member of the Universal Church at the moment of grace salvation.

(1 Cor.3:16-17) **"Do you not know** (oida/ perf.a.ind2pl) <u>that</u> (hoti) **you are** (eimi/ p.a.ind.2pl) the temple (naos) of God <u>and that</u> the Spirit of God dwells in you (en+loc/ su/ lplm)? If (1cc = true) any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for <u>the temple of God is holy, and that is</u> what you are."

(1 Cor.12:13) "For by one Spirit we were <u>baptized into one body</u>, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were <u>all made to drink of one Spirit</u>."

Worship of God takes place in the spiritual believer's body; and, when he joins other believers for worship of God through Christ, which is called the local Church.

4. The indwelling of Holy Spirit becomes the spiritual fountain of God's living water for the abundant life.

Jesus to the Samaritan woman

(John 4:10) "If (2cc = assumed to be false) you knew the **gift of God**, (which you don't) and **who it is who** says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' (who you don't know) you would have asked Him, and **He would have given you** <u>Living Water</u> (also assume false / which He won't do).""

(John 4:14) "Whoever (hos) [relative pronoun] (Positive Volition to the message) drinks of the water that <u>I will give</u> him shall NEVER thirst; but the water that <u>I will give</u> him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life." (John 10:10)

Jesus to His disciple and footnoted to us

(John 7:38-39) "**He who believes in Me**, as the Scripture said, 'From **his innermost being** will flow rivers of **living water**.' **But He spoke of the Spirit**, whom **those who believed in Him were to receive**; for **the Spirit** was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified."
