THE TEACH & RECALL MINISTRY OF HOLY SPIRIT

In lesson one, we outlined seven Foundation Doctrines of the Holy Spirit taught by Jesus to His disciples at the Last Supper (john 14-16).

In lessons two and three, we studied three questions asked of Jesus by His disciples and His answers during the Last Supper.

It was the <u>first foundation doctrine</u> of the Indwelling of Holy Spirit, which came from the PHILIP SECTION, that led me to discuss these doctrines. (John 14:8-21; specifically, vs. 16-18).

In this, our fourth lesson we will discuss the <u>second foundation doctrine</u> of the Holy Spirit's ministry (John 14:22-31).

It comes from Judas' (not Iscariot) question,

(Jn.14:22) "Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, 'Lord, what then has happened (ginomai/perf.a.ind.3ps) that (hoti) You are going to disclose (mello/p.a.ind.2ps) (emphanizo/p.a.infin) [a periphrqstic] Yourself to us, and not to the world?"

Jesus had given the answer to this question previously to them in (John 14:15-18) and (Matt.16:21-23), but His disciples were not listening, nor looking for answers - because they believed they already had them!

Four aspects of Jesus' doctrinal answer of the Teach & Recall Ministry of the Holy Spirit.

1. Jesus' answer to Judas' question is another long section for study (John 14:22-31).

Judas' question: (Jn.14:22).

Jesus' answer (Jn.14:23-31) - I listed five Categorical Bible Doctrines (CBD).

•	CBD	(Jn.14:23-24)	The Love of God the Father for the world.
•	CBD	(Jn.14:25-27)	The Teach & recalling ministry of God the Holy Spirit.
•	CBD	(Jn.14:27)	The Peace of Christ is greater than the worlds.
•	CBD	(Jn.14:28-29)	The Plan of God is even greater than Christ.
•	CBD	(Jn.14:30-31)	That Christ and the Plan of God are greater than Satan.

2. Like the other disciples of Jesus, Judas son of James, is struggling with cycling certain CBD from his mind to his heart (2 Tim.3:16-17).

NOTE: Judas (not Iscariot) is listed in (Luke 6:12-16) and (Acts 1:13).

Judas, son of James, is like many of us, not well-known by many, but a devoted disciple of Jesus Christ. His question shows he is still struggling with the messiahship of Jesus Christ by asking:

[&]quot;Lord, why do you intend to show yourself to us and not to the world?" (John 14:22)

WHY? Because Judas does not have a **frame of reference** in his heart for this doctrine of the revelation of the indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit (taking the place of Jesus Christ in their lives) even though Jesus has taught them time and time again! (John 14:1617; 16:7; Matt.3:11; Acts 1:5).

Judas represented a believer who has had a **breakdown of the Faith Cycle.** The teaching of Jesus at the Last Supper had not been processed <u>from their minds to their hearts of their soul!</u> They did not understand:

(2 Tim.3:16-17) "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work."

They were struggling with previous held beliefs of the coming Messiahship and what was currently being taught by Jesus (Himself) to them.

- 3. To understand their spiritual struggle, we need to understand the spiritual make-up of the soul and how it functions in life of believer (1 Thess.5:23/ read).
 - The Soul consists of Self-consciousness, Conscience, Mentality, Volition, and Emotion.
 - o We will focus on mentality because Judas and the other disciples were struggling in this area.
 - Mentality_consists of the mind (perception/ Jesus was teaching New Covenant truths) and the heart
 - o Comprehension: The disciples are struggling from Old Covenant viewpoint of Messiah.

(2 Cor.3:2-3) "You are our **letter**, written in our hearts, knowing and red by all men, being manifested that you are a letter of Christ, cared for by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts."

4. The Heart has five tablets:

a.	Memory Center	Short and long recall (John 14:26-27)
b.	Frame of Reference	The Divine approach to life's experiences
c.	Vocabulary	Bible Doctrine, The Word association and communication CBD
d.	Beliefs	Divine Viewpoint regarding cosmos lies (John 8:44) and Divine Truth
		(Phil.2:5)
e.	Spiritual IQ	The ability to comprehend, retain, and apply CBD to life experiences.
	-	(John 8:32; Eph.1:18).

(2 Cor.4:4) <u>"In whose case the god of this world</u> has **blinded the minds of the unbelieving** so that they might <u>not see the light of the gospel of the glory of</u> Christ, who is the image of God." (2 Cor.4:4-6; 1 Cor.2:14)

HOME STUDY

- Jesus <u>closed the Judas section</u> with a three-fold promise to believers in (John 14:27-31).
 - The Peace of Christ is greater than the world's (Jn.14:27) (John 14:1-4).
 - The Plan of God is greater than even Christ (Jn.14:28-29) (John 16:7; 7:37-39).
 - The Perpetual Satanic attack against the Plan of God in the world during the Church Age (Jn.14:30-31) (John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11; 1 John 4:4; 5:19 and Eph.6:10-17).
