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## **CONVICTION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

This series will study **Seven Foundation Doctrines** of the Holy Spirit from John 14-16. In this study we will cover the:

### Four aspects of the Conviction Ministry of The Holy Spirit.

1. The Greek word for conviction is elegcho or elencho.

Its root meaning is to expose and lay bear the facts of truth.

It is translated in English with four ideas by the Greek-English Lexicon of New Testament by Bauer, Arndt, Gingrich (pg.248)

- 1st "Bring to light, expose set forth" (Eph.5:11,13)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> "Convict, convince, or point out someone of something" (John 16:7-11)
- 3rd "Reprove, rebuke, correct" (Matt.18:15; 1`Tim.5:20; 2 Tim.4:2)
- 4<sup>th</sup> "Heightened, punish, discipline" (Heb.12:5; Rev.3:19)
- 2. Jesus used three special phrases to reveal Categorical Bible Doctrine regarding the completion of His mission to earth and the advent mission of The Holy Spirit.
  - In (John 14-16), Jesus used the phrase "these things" ten times (14:25-26; 15:11, 21; 16:1, 3, 4a, 4b, 6, 25, 33) to teach pertinent Categorical Bible Doctrine of His messianic mission.
  - In (John 12:23-24; 13:1; 16:2, 4, 25, 32; and 17:1), Jesus used the phrase "HIS HOUR" to refer to His death, burial, resurrection, and exaltation to right hand of God in heaven.
    - o (John 17:1) "Jesus spoke 'these things' and lifted up His eyes to Heaven, He said, 'the hour has come; glorify Your son, that the Son may glorify You."
  - In (John 14:19-20) and (John 16:16-22), Jesus used the phrase "Little While" to teach the nearest of the time of completion of His mission and of His departure and of the near Advent of The Holy Spirit.
- 3. In (John 16:1-15), Jesus taught the 4th (16:7-11), 5th (16:12-13a), and 6th (13b-15) Foundation Doctrines of the Holy Spirit.

In this study we introduce Jesus' lesson on Convicting of the World with a phrase of importance:

(John 16:7) "But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if (3cc) I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if (3cc) I go, I will send Him to you (2pl)."

(these two 3cc (if) set doctrinal alternatives)

<u>The **YOU**</u> were the 120 believers waiting for the Advent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 1:5, 15, and 2:1; Matt.3:11) (fulfillment).

# 4. The Convicting ministry of the Holy Spirit of (John 16:7-11) will begin at Pentecost of (Acts 2) and continue until the Rapture of the Church (1 Thess.4:13-18).

We will examine the conviction ministry of the Holy Spirit of (John 16:7-11) by the following two homiletic points.

Jesus began with a special phrase used to introduce an important doctrine - "But I tell you the truth (Categorical Bible Doctrine) of the Messianic Hour and Advent of The Holy Spirit."

#### (John 16:7-11)

#### (Jn.16:7)

- The Advantage of The Holy Spirit:
  - o "It is to your advantage (sumphero/p.a.ind.3ps) that I go away." (read John 14:12)
- "For if (3cc) do not go away,
  - o the helper (ho parakletos) will not come."
- "But if (3cc) I go,
  - o I will send Him to you."

## (Jn.16:8-11)

- The Advent of the Holy Spirit:
  - o "And when He comes (erchomai/ a.a.ptc.nsm),
- **He will convict** (elegcho/ f.a.ind.3ps) **the world** (ton kosmos/ asm)
  - o of sin (hamatia/gsf), and
  - o of righteousness (dikaiosune/ gsf) and
  - o of judgment (krisis/ gsf)."
- **Concerning Sin (16:9**/ John 15:18-27)
  - o "Because (hoti+men) they (world) (John 3:16) believe not (pisteuo/p.a.ind.3pl/ ouk) in Me."
- Concerning Righteousness (16:10)
  - o "Because (hoti+de) <u>I go (hupago/ p.a.ind.1ps)</u> to the Father and you no longer see (theoreo/ me/ p.a.ind.1ps) Me."
  - o (Read Rom.5:12-21)
- Concerning Judgment (16:11)
  - o "Because (hoti+de) the ruler of this world (ho archon tou kosmos) has been judged." (krino) (perf.p.ind.3ps) (John 12:31; 1 John 5:19; Matt.25:41; Rev.12:3-17; 20:2, 10-15)
