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## THE DISCLOSURE MINISTRY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

In our lesson text, Jesus taught the fifth (Guidance ministry) and sixth (Disclosure ministry) Foundation Doctrines of the Indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit.

## Three aspects of the Disclosure Ministry of the indwelling Holy Spirit

1. Jesus mentioned the Disclosure ministry of the Indwelling Holy Spirit (IHS) in each verse of our lesson text.

The Greek word for disclosure is **anagello** which is translated into English as declare, announce, report, shew (KJB), and disclosure (NASB). "Disclose is expose to view or to make known publically."

It is used in each verse of John 16:13-15 and forms a study outline.

- 16:13 Report Future "But whatever He hears, He will speak; and He (IHS) will disclose to you what is to come."
- 16:14 Reflective Glory "He will glorify Me, for He will take of mine and disclose it to you."
- 16:15 Represent Plan of God "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore, I said that He would take of mine and will disclose it to you."
- 2. One disclosure ministry of indwelling Holy Spirit is reflective glory of Christ.

(John 16:14) "He will glorify (doxazo/f.a.ind.3ps) Me, for (hoti) [because/ explains how] He will take (lambano/f.m.ind.3ps) of Mine and disclose (anagello/f.a.ind.3ps) it to you."

Repeat (John 16:13) (hears and speaks) and report (John 16:14) [all things] are two key parts of the reflective glory of Christ in the Disclosure Ministry of Indwelling Holy Spirit (John 16:15).

Jesus had been teaching on the doctrine of reflective glory during the Last Supper period (John 13-17). He taught on it in each chapter: (John 13:31-31; 14:13-14; 15:8; 16:14; 17:1-6 22, 24)

Reflective Glory: "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him. If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately." (John 13:31-32)


(John 15:8) "By this is My Father glorified, that **you bear much fruit**, and so prove to be My disciples."

3. In, Jesus used the causal conjunction (hoti) [for or because] to introduce how reflective glory works in the Christian Way of Life.

(John 16:14) "He will glorify Me, for (hoti) He will take of Mine and disclose it to you."

Reflective glory comes with the cycling of Categorical Bible Doctrine by faith using the faith cycle.



## The Son of God to The Father:

"I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given to Me to do. Now Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world. I have manifested Your name to the men whom You gave Me out of the world; they were Yours and You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word." (John 17:4-6 and 24) (John 17) is a love letter by Jesus in prayer.

## The Children of God to The Father:

"But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the spirit." (2 Cor.3:18; 4:6-7; Rom.8:14-17, 29-30; 12:2)
