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## ETERNAL LIFE IN A MORTAL BODY

This year's (2021) Easter lesson is taken from: (Rom.8:9-11) "He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you."

- 1. Paul opened chapter Eight of Romans establishing two doctrinal truths: (Rom.8:1-8).
  - One regarding false teaching against grace salvation.
  - One regarding where and how to set the mind regarding the Christian Way of Life

Pay attention to <u>FOUR additional doctrinal</u> points regarding the ministry of the Indwelling Holy Spirit. (2Pet.3:14-18).

Our FIRST doctrinal truth is "the Law of the Spirit of (eternal) Life."

o (Rom.8:1-4) "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death" (Rom.5:12; 1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9).

Our SECOND doctrinal truth is "the Mind set on the Indwelling Spirit is not "set" on the flesh (Old Sin Nature)"

- o (Rom.8:5-8) The internal struggle is between the mind set on the <u>flesh verse set on the Spirit</u> because "Those in the flesh **cannot please God.**" (Rom.8:8; Gal.5:16-17)
- 2. Now Paul turns his attention to those who set their minds on the power of the Indwelling Holy Spirit over the flesh.

**NOTE #2:** Paul used <u>four Greek markers</u> (using the word "if") to teach four more important doctrinal truths regarding the ministry of the Indwelling Holy Spirit. All four Greek markers are all 1<sup>st</sup> Class Condition (if) = maybe. The 1<sup>st</sup> Class "if" (1cc) conditional clause also means that both the protasis (**if** clause) and apodosis, the (**then** clause) are important doctrinal TRUTHS.

Paul is giving doctrinal answers to (Rom. 8:8) "Those who are in the flesh cannot please God."

Question: "Then how can a Church Age Believer please God?"

3. In the FIRST, 1st Class Condition (if) of (Rom.8:9a), Paul gave the apodosis (then) before the protasis (1st Class Condition) to emphasize a doctrinal point.

"However (1cc apodosis = then), you are **not** in the **flesh but in** the **Spirit (Gal.5:16-17)**, <u>if (1cc protasis = and this</u> is also true) **indeed** the **Spirit of God dwells** (oikeo) (p.a.ind.3ps) **in you** (en+locative of place/ su/ n plural m)."

**NOTE** #3: (Rom. 8:9a) The Indwelling Holy Spirit takes up residence inside the Church Age Believer's body the moment of Grace Salvation (John 14:16-17; 1 Cor.6:19-20; Rom.8:9-11).

Paul put the 2<sup>nd</sup> (if) clause <u>first</u> to add a second doctrinal truth in (Rom. 8:9b): "But <u>if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ</u>, **he** (houstos/ nsm) **does not belong** (ouk eimi/ p.a.nd.3ps) **to Him** (autos/ gsm/possessive genitive).

NOTE #4: (Rom.8:9b): "If anyone does have the Indwelling Holy Spirit, he/ she does NOT belong to God in Christ." (2 Cor.5:17; Jude 6; 1 Cor.2:14; 1 Cor.3:1-3)

Now Paul comes to the third 1<sup>st</sup> Class "if" clause in (**Rom.8:10**): "**If** (1cc) **Christ** <u>is in you</u>, though (men) the body is dead because of sin [our position in Adam (Gal.2:20)], yet (de) <u>the spirit</u> (human spirit, small "s") is alive because of righteousness (our position IN Christ (2 Cor.5:21)." (note the men/de sequence)

*Our THIRD* doctrinal truth found in (Rom.8:10): "When the Indwelling Holy Spirit takes up residence in side the mortal body of a Church Age Believer, his/ her body is consider **dead to sin** (Adamic Sin Curse and our imputed Old Sin Nature) yet the human spirit is alive because the mortal body (being) **dead to sin is now the Holy of Holies** (The NAOS) (1 Cor.6:19-20) where God dwells because of God's Righteousness IN Christ (1 John 3:5; <u>2</u> Cor.6:16).

Our FOURTH doctrinal truth is found in (Rom.8:11): "But if (1cc) the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells (oikeo/p.a.ind.3ps) in you, (then) He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life (zoopoieo/f.a.ind.3ps) to your mortal bodies (ta thnetos soma/apln) through (dia+ablative of agent) His Spirit who dwells (enoikeo/p.a.ptc.ablsn) in you (l.pl.m)."

NOTE #5: The fourth additional doctrinal truth is the title of our lesson from (Rom.8:11) "Eternal Life in a Mortal Body."

It is the Indwelling Holy Spirit that is the agent of **eternal life** in the (naos) body of a Church Age Believer, (John 14:16-17; 1 John 5:11-13).

Our lesson has taught you SIX doctrinal principles of
