Lesson: CIRCUMCISION OF ABRAHAM

Text: Gen.17:9-14

We will pause at Col. 2:11-15 before discussing the Circumcision by Christ. It is important to teach on the origin of biblical circumcision from Gen.17:9-14.

Biblical circumcision was given by God to Abraham when he was 99 (17:1). This was 24 years after leaving the Haran to go to Promised Land (Gen.12:1-5/ age of 75).

This lesson will study **five aspects** of the Circumcision of Abraham.

1. Abraham's circumcision was given by El Shaddai God Almighty as a sign of Abrahamic Covenant (Gen.17:1).

Gen.17:1-27 can be divided into four parts for study: 17:1-8; 17:9-14; 17:15-22; and 17:23-27.

We will be studying Gen.17:9-14 and the circumcision of Abraham. The Circumcision of Abraham was a sign of an everlasting covenant.

- Everlasting Covenant is mentioned three times (17:7, 13, 19)
- "My (El Shaddai) Covenant" is mentioned seven times (17:2, 4, 7, 10, 14, 19, 21).
- 2. The Abrahamic Covenant consisted of three major promises recorded in Gen.12:1-3.
- Promise of land (12:1; 13:15-17).
- Promise of seed (12:3; 13:16)
- Promise of blessings (12:1-3/ grace blessing/ barak is used 4 times).

Remember, it is referred to as an Everlasting Covenant of El Shaddai.

3. Gen.17:9-14 tells us that Abrahamic Covenant was a sign of Importance to All the nations of the world. "And in you **ALL the families of the earth** will be blessed." (12:3/ USA/ Moody, Al.)

Paul taught that "All the FAMILIES of the earth could be blessed in CHRIST (Gal.3:6-18)." "The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say 'and to seeds,' meaning to many people, but 'and to your seed,' meaning one person, who is Christ." (Gal.3:16)

4. In **Gal.3:6-18**, Paul taught that the Circumcision of Abrahm was a sign of an unconditional and everlasting covenant to everyone who believes that Jesus Christ died for their sins was buried and raised on the third day

"Those who believe are children of Abraham (Gal.3:7)."

"Scriptures (Gen. 12 and 17) foresaw that God would justify the **Gentiles by faith** and announced **the gospel** in advance to Abraham: 'All the nations will be blessed through you.' So **those who have faith are blessed** along with Abraham, the man of faith." (Gal. 3:8-9)

- 5. "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law (ML) by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: 'Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree (Deut.21:23).' Christ redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit." (Gal.3:13-14/ 1Cor 15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9)
 - In OC, it was a prophetic gospel. Circumcision of Abraham was a sign of the first coming of Christ.
 - In **NC**, it is a **historical gospel**. Circumcision of Christ is the sign of the Second Coming of Christ.
 - Matthew's genealogy starts with Abraham to Jesus Christ (Matt.1:1-17).

WARNING: Abrahamic Covenant issues a warning to **all nations** regarding **antisemitism** – "I will bless those who bless you and I will curse those who curse you (Gen.12:3/ El Shaddai).
